**PROPOSED ORDINANCE**

An Ordinance To Amend The Zoning Ordinance Number 16-91 As Last Amended Of The City Of Clanton, In Order To Permit A Certain Parcel Or Parcels Of Land With Improvements Thereon, Located Within The Corporate Limits Of The City Of Clanton To Be Legally Used For Purposes As Provided In Said Existing Ordinance And To Amend Said Ordinance, As Provided By Law.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Clanton, Chilton County, Alabama, a municipality in regular meeting assembled: That Ordinance entitled Zoning Ordinance of the City of Clanton, Alabama, as last amended, and being Ordinance No. 16-91 be amended as follows:

That certain lots or parcels of land located within the city limits of the City of Clanton, Alabama be rezoned from (Parcel 'B') MR to R-1-A, (Parcel 'C') MR to RG in order that the same may be Legally used for purposes defined in said Ordinance and being described as follows:

**LEGAL DESCRIPTION - PARCEL 'B'**  
Begin at the Northeast corner of the Southwest Vi of the Southeast 3/4 of Section 15, Township 22 North, Range 14 East; thence run South along the East line of said 1/4-1/4 for 1144.91'; thence turn an angle to the right of 89°32'15" and run West for 1266.27' to a point on the East right-of-way of Chilton County Road 633; thence turn an angle to the right of 89°45'13" and run North along the East right-of-way for 1157.32' to the North line of the SW 1/4 of the SE/4; thence turn an angle to the right of 90°48'10" and run East along the North line of said 1/4-1/4 for 1280.55' to the point of beginning.

**LESS AND EXCEPT** the following: Commence at the Northeast corner of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 15, Township 22 North, Range 14 East; thence run South along the East line of the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 for 1144.91'; thence turn an angle to the right of 89° 32' 15" and run West for 633.37' to the point of beginning; thence continue along the last described course for 632.91' to the East right-of-way of Chilton County Road No. 633; thence turn an angle to the right of 89° 45' 13" and run North along the East right-of-way for 48.68'; thence turn an angle to the right of 94° 38' 35" and run Southeast for 634.99' to the point of beginning. Contains 0.3536 acre.

**LEGAL DESCRIPTION - PARCEL 'C'**  
A parcel of land, lying in the Northwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 15, Township 22 North, Range 14 East, Chilton County, Alabama, being more particularly described as follows:

BEGIN at a rebar found, locally accepted to be the Northeast corner of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of said Section 15; thence South 01 degrees 24 minutes 57 seconds East along the East line of said 1/4-1/4 section for a distance of 465.84 feet to a 1/2" rebar found capped "Moates"; thence leaving said East line, South 89 degrees 10 minutes 48 seconds West for a distance of 1177.44 feet to a 1/2" rebar found on the Southeast right of way margin of County Road 633 (80' right of way), said point being on a curve to the right, having a radius of 1220.38 feet, a chord bearing of North 31 degrees 29 minutes 19 seconds East and a chord length of 131.46 feet; thence along the arc of said curve and along said right of way for a distance of 131.52 feet to a 1/2" rebar; thence North 34 degrees 34 minutes 34 seconds East, continuing along said right of way for a distance of 442.59 feet to a 1/2" rebar found capped "Moates" located on the North line of said 1/4-1/4 section; thence North 89 degrees 35 minutes 29 seconds East along said North line for a distance of 846.00 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING. Containing 10.94 acres, more or less.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all further terms and conditions of said Ordinance, as last amended, are hereby confirmed and adopted, except as hereby provided.

**This Week At Bethany**

**Sunday, March 10**

Bethany met and sang "Glory To His Name," and heard a message from Hebrews 12, 13 that was presented by Bro. Glenn. These last two chapters are the conclusion of the letter by the writer, possibly the Apostle Paul, to the early Christians who were struggling with the desire to go back under the law.

He was trying to show them how much better they are with Jesus than they were under the law. Our sin-nature sometimes takes over and, unless we are close to God, we will go back into our sinful ways.

The cloud of witnesses are the ones who stayed true to the word of God and His teachings. He told them they too can accomplish great things even though they make mistakes and sin. Look at all those past saints and the victory they had through God.

Do not get discouraged, there will be victory in Jesus. Put your faith in Jesus Christ and follow Him. 12:2 says 'looking unto Jesus,' is the key to staying true to Him. If drawing a straight line we need to focus on the end of the line, not where your pen is at the time. The same is true for us to stay on the right path for Jesus, focus on Him and our Heavenly Home, not where we are at the moment.

Verse 4, as long as we are living and have breath in us, we must continue to work for God. He has a plan for our lives. Verse 6, the Lord chastens those He loves just like parents chastise their children. If we do not waver from our faith, we will not face the discipline of God. How should we react when we are chastised?

1.) Accept, but do nothing about our life, lesson not learned!. 2.) Self-pity, I do not deserve this punishment, I did nothing wrong. God is just and will not give us any discipline we do NOT deserve. 3.) Anger, or resentment, I can't believe God would do that to me. Whose fault is it? It is not God's fault, He did nothing, we did, OUR fault! 4.) Accept our chastisement gratefully.

How? Understand that discipline is there to keep us on the right path. When we do wrong our testimony, witness and prayer-life is broken. We need to realize we need to get back on track. Be thankful He doesn't leave us to fend for ourselves. Learn from our wrong doings and make necessary changes to avoid discipline.

In verses 21, 22 we have two mountains. Mt. Sinai, which was before Jesus came on earth dying for us. He made God more approachable when he came. Moses was afraid on Mt. Sinai when He was in the presence of God. Then we have Mt. Zion, there is comfort and peace after Jesus died on the cross making access to God easier.

We can pray to God seeing the comfort and peace from Him. Take advantage of praying to Him often. The more we pray, the less we are to stray back into

our old ways. In Chapter 13 there are three main points. 1.) Verse 1, "Let Brotherly Love Continue," treat everyone as your neighbor. Love is the key. Jesus said to His disciples before ascending to Heaven, "Love One Another."

To please God, we must have Love!, 2.) Verse 6, Fear not what man can do to you. Man can torture and kill you for your faith, but do not fear, Heaven is coming. If you die for your faith to God, you will be in the presence of God and will have peace. 3.) Verse 18, pray for each other. Prayer is easy and is very important and powerful.

We closed the early service with a song, "I Am Praying For You," and a prayer.

We had our Men's and Ladies meetings followed with the Business Meeting. We then went to our Sunday School classes and afterward sang "I Know That My Redeemer Liveth," and "Come Unto Me." Bro. Aubry then brought the 11:00 o'clock message from John 3:1-15, "Jesus And Nicodemus." Nicodemus was a powerful, religious and wealthy man who was unsaved. He called Jesus a "Rabbi," or teacher who had come from God.

Jesus told Him he was a master of Israel. Nicodemus came to Jesus with a question about Jesus and how to get to Heaven. Jesus told him he must be born again. He was a rich man and well respected in his community, as well as being a Pharisee who worked at keeping the law of God.

We need the righteousness of Jesus Christ to go to Heaven. As we, Nicodemus could not understand how you could be born once you are already born. He was asking Jesus for the answer he needed. Jesus said, you must be born of the Spirit. We do not understand, but must accept by faith.

We do not let the mystery of electricity keep us from using it, and neither should we let our ignorance about Heaven keep us from being saved for ALL eternity. If you could lose your salvation, you could NEVER be saved again.

Jesus in verse 8 is talking about the calling by the Holy Spirit for us to be saved. It is like the wind that blows and when it is gone, it is gone. A tornado may come and never come in the same place again. When the Holy Spirit is pulling at your heart, answer the call to salvation.

Jesus left His throne in Heaven and came to earth to live like us so that He could pay the price for our sin. He died for the SIN of the human race which includes all the sin of all people, past, present and future. Nicodemus was possibly saved that night and became a follower of Jesus.

John 2:24, 25 Jesus knows each and every person and doesn't need anyone telling him about others. No one needs to know or understand the Bible to be saved. They only need to realize they are lost!

We closed services with a song "You Must Be Born Again," and a prayer.
