We have had nearly a year of dissension and terrible disagreement over this choice -- apparently **made BY THE PEOPLE!**

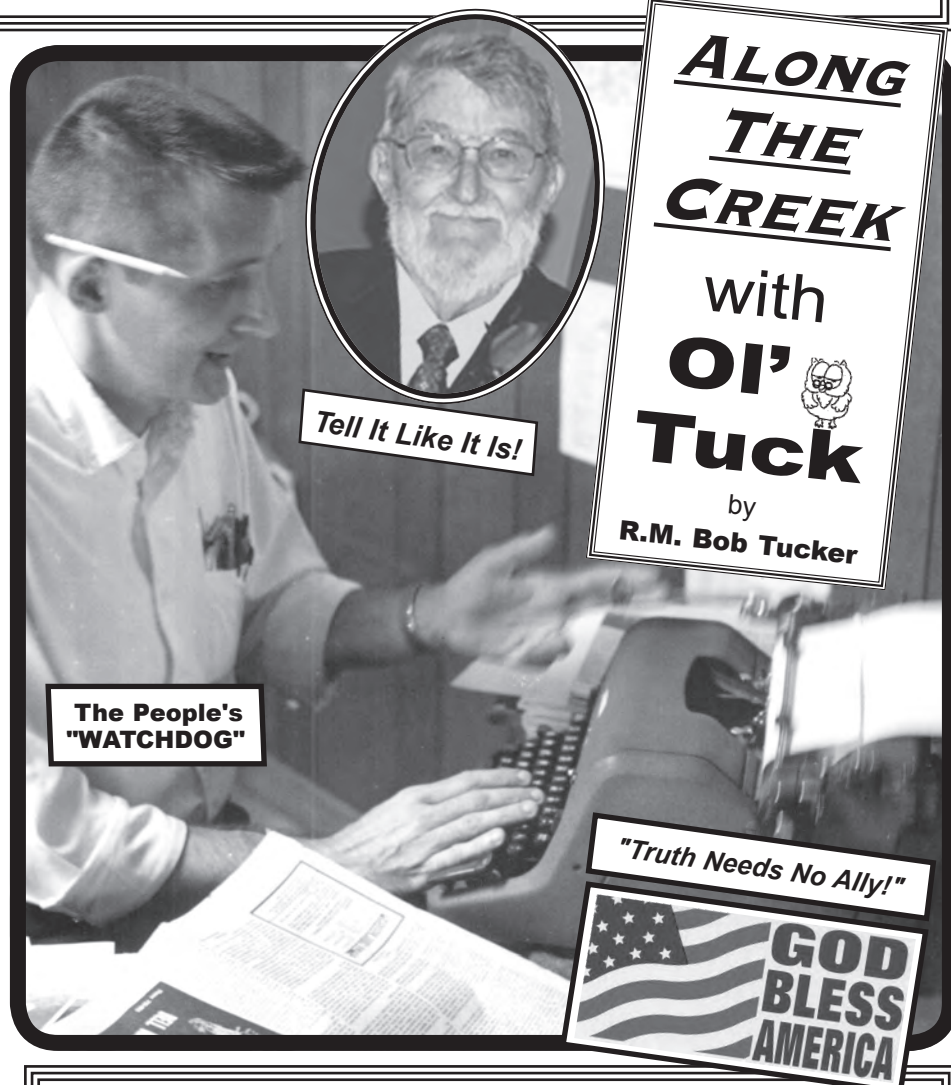
